

End of Tenancy Cleaning Checklist

The End of Tenancy cleaning can be described as a top-to-bottom cleaning of the entire property in which special attention is paid to all small details until a good property condition is obtained. All personal belongings must be removed. A proper professional service is crucial for anyone who is at the end of a tenancy contract and wants to receive his / her deposit back. Failure to assure a good level of cleanliness can cause the security deposit to be deducted partially or fully.

Kitchen

- ☐ Dusting of all light switches and plugs
- ☐ Hoover, mop and polish all floors
- ☐ Removing rubbish and clean all bins inside the property
- ☐ Wipe the radiators
- ☐ Properly clean the dishwasher from in and outside
- ☐ Remove the lime scale where it is found
- ☐ Remove all food leftovers, bags, etc.
- ☐ Remove the mould growth where it is found
- ☐ All shelves, cupboards and drawers are to be properly cleaned inside and outside
- ☐ All kitchen countertops, tables, near the sink areas to be washed, dried and polished afterwards
- ☐ The kitchen sink and taps to be cleaned and polished
- ☐ All kitchen tiled areas to be disinfected, wiped and de-greased
- ☐ Degrease and properly clean the oven in and outside
- ☐ Clean and degrease the extractor fans, hobs, gas rings, etc.
- ☐ Properly clean and disinfect the microwave from in and outside
- ☐ The fridge/freezer must be defrosted in advance, so it could be cleaned to the best possible level, including disposing of food deposits, dirt, grime, etc.
- ☐ A proper clean of the washing machine, including the rubber, the door, in and outside
- ☐ All small appliances to be externally cleaned / wiped as well – like a toaster, kettle, etc.
- ☐ All windows to be cleaned internally – including the frames, window sills and ledges
- ☐ All skirting boards, doors, door handles, frames, etc. to be properly wiped

Bathroom

- ☐ The toilet seats and all other utilities should be properly cleaned, brushed and sanitised;
- ☐ Extractor fans should be cleaned
- ☐ All floors to be hoovered and mopped
- ☐ All waste and rubbish/bin bags to be removed
- ☐ All mirrors and other bathroom furniture to be wiped and polished
- ☐ Bottles of shampoos, shower gels, old products to be thrown away

End of Tenancy Cleaning Checklist

- ☐ All doors, fittings to be cleaned with a damp cloth
- ☐ Glass doors to be carefully cleaned
- ☐ Cobwebs to be removed if any
- ☐ Bath tubs, showers, tiles, sinks, etc. to be properly cleaned and if there is any lime scale or mould – to be removed.

Bedrooms and living rooms

- ☐ All floors, carpeted areas, rugs, mattresses and upholstery to be vacuum cleaned
- ☐ Mop to be done on all hard floors/ laminated areas
- ☐ All shelves, cupboards, units, wardrobes to be cleaned from in and outside
- ☐ Cobwebs to be removed, the whole property to be dusted, including door handles, frames, paintings, other art
- ☐ Curtain rails to be dusted
- ☐ All light switches, sockets, plugs, fittings to be wiped
- ☐ The fireplace and its surroundings to be cleaned up externally

Entrance, hallway and stairs

- ☐ All windows to be cleaned internally
- ☐ All cobwebs to be carefully removed – if there are any
- ☐ The back and front doors to be cleaned, wiped and polished
- ☐ Hoover to be properly done to the highest possible level
- ☐ If there are any shoe marks, to be treated and cleaned
- ☐ A mop of all hallways, stairs, spaces where possible to be done
- ☐ Dusting of all light switches, skirting boards, door handles, lighting fixtures, hangers

Furnishings:

- ☐ Any stains to be cleaned to the best possible level / completely removed
- ☐ The vacuuming of the curtains and window decorations to be done very carefully on a low setting to prevent/avoid any problems
- ☐ A minimum amount of water to be used when cleaning any furniture in order to avoid marks or damages
- ☐ Dusting to be carefully done where it was accumulated the most, using a soft brush where needed
- ☐ All small, hard to reach areas to be paid attention to with the needed extra care

End of Tenancy Cleaning Checklist

Carpets

- ☐ All light furniture that is in the way of cleaning to be moved and cleaned under / behind
- ☐ A proper vacuuming to be done and repeated if needed to ensure a higher level of cleanliness
- ☐ If needed, a professional steam cleaning to be done to treat any stains, stubborn dirt

Drawers and cupboards

- ☐ The shelves, cupboards, wardrobes, etc. must be emptied of personal belongings and cleaned
- ☐ Any dirt in and outside of the drawers, cabinets, cupboards to be wiped, dusted, scrubbed to the best possible level
- ☐ All handles, doors, glass doors, etc. to be wiped and polished

Appliances:

Fridge

- ☐ The freezer should be defrosted in advance and then cleaned, so a good level of cleaning can be reached
- ☐ The rubber seals, and the fridge/freezer from both in and outside to be cleaned
- ☐ If there is any remaining, melted ice/water, to be absorbed with a cloth
- ☐ The dirt from behind and under to be properly taken care of if accessible
- ☐ All shelves, inside cupboard of the fridge/freezer to be washed and cleaned
- ☐ If there are any marks, stains, leftovers, to be removed

Tumble dryer

- ☐ The filter to be checked and cleaned
- ☐ The rubber seal to be cleaned
- ☐ The soap dispenser drawer to be checked for dirt leftovers and sanitised
- ☐ Clean the appliance from both in and outside

End of Tenancy Cleaning Checklist

Toaster

- ☐ The toaster to be unplugged and let to cool if it was recently used, before cleaning it
- ☐ To be dried carefully after the cleaning to make sure it is safe to be used again
- ☐ While cleaning it to be extra careful as sometimes the toaster is full of dried breadcrumbs that can cause quite a mess – to put a paper towel under it
- ☐ To make sure that no marks or stains are left on the toaster and to polish it as well

Oven and microwave

- ☐ Remove all trays, racks, etc. before the cleaning
- ☐ Clean the appliance both from in and outside, to the best possible level, making sure to get rid of any grease, burns, marks
- ☐ Polish and clean all handles, clean the glass parts
- ☐ Clean underneath and behind when accessible

Dishwasher

- ☐ Make sure the appliance is empty before the cleaning starts
- ☐ To be sanitised both from in and outside, any soap building or leftover food to be removed
- ☐ A damp cloth with vinegar and water solution to be used for cleaning, also possibly baking soda as well for tougher stains
- ☐ The appliance to be dried with a paper towel to make sure it is ready to be used again

Washing machine

- ☐ Please make sure that the appliance is left empty.
- ☐ The washing machine to be cleaned both in and outside, any build up grime, dirt and hair to be removed
- ☐ A damp cloth to be used to carefully clean the rubber seals, handles and screen
- ☐ The external side of the appliance to be wiped, including under and behind if possible
- ☐ All surfaces to be dried and polished afterwards to make sure it is safe and ready to be used again.

Outside of the property

If you have a clause in your contract, stating that as a tenant you are responsible for the external area of the property as well, please pay attention to the following:

- ☐ Cleaning, repairing of any fences, gates, borders
- ☐ The garage or shed – to be clean and In a proper condition
- ☐ Prune, weed and cutting grass
- ☐ Trimming
- ☐ Cleaning of any driveways, patios, paths, gardens, etc.
- ☐ Fixing any external lightning or decorations.
